Messina(Sicily), October 3-6, 2018

## Second Announcement

The 38<sup>th</sup> yearly Congress of the *Italian Society for the History of Physics and Astronomy* (SISFA) will take place on October 3-6, 2018. The main venue will be in Messina (Sicily), at the *Accademia Peloritana dei Pericolanti*. A thematic session on the History of Astronomy will also take place in Reggio Calabria, at the *Planetario Pythagoras*. Shuttle transportation from Messina to Reggio Calabria will be on behalf of the local organizing committee.

**The Congress:** The Meeting is one of a well-established series that SISFA has been organizing on a yearly basis since its foundation. It aims at promoting the scholarly study of the history of physics and astronomy in Italy not only by professionals focusing on these areas in research institutions but also by independent scholars and school teachers willing to explore the role of the history of physics and astronomy in present-day teaching of the disciplines. At the same time, the Meeting provides an opportunity to strengthen old and establish new links among the members of SISFA and the members of other scholarly societies, as well as researchers working in the same and in related fields. Historians of physics and astronomy are then invited to participate and the invitation is extended to all the scholars and researchers sharing the same kind of interests.

-The Meeting will host both invited talks and oral communications. The official languages will be both Italian and English. More detailed information and updating will soon appear on the Meeting web site <http://www.sisfa.org/convegni/xxxviii/>

-The 1<sup>st</sup> SISFA Best Paper Prize 2017 – dedicated to young authors – will be awarded during the SISFA 2018 meeting.

**Topics:** Proposals for oral communications should mainly address the history of physics and astronomy, also in connection with the related areas of mathematics, chemistry and the history of science and culture. Studies focusing on historical instruments and documentary sources regarding the mentioned fields are also relevant, as well as the applications of the history of physics and astronomy in science education and museum displays.

**Topical sessions:** The year 2018 is dense of anniversaries, among which the disappearance of Ettore Majorana (1938), the promulgation of the racial laws in Italy (1938), with their negative impact also on national science, and the birth (1818) of Angelo Secchi, one of the founders of modern astrophysics. Specific Topical sessions will consider these important figures and events on the basis of recent scholarly research in the history of physics and astronomy. Another Topical session will focus on scientific instruments.

**Outline of the Congress:** The Congress will host invited talks and communications. The official languages are Italian and English.

**Video shooting:** Invited talks will be broadcast live streaming; videos of any talk will be put on a dedicated channel of YouTube (unless explicit refusal by the contributor).

**Venue and Places:** The Meeting will be hosted at the Accademia Peloritana dei Pericolanti-Messina, an institution engaged in promoting cultural events within the local territory (<http://www.accademiapeloritana.it/>), and University of Messina (<http://www.unime.it>), Messina, is a maritime town (<https://www.italyguides.it/it/sicilia/messina>) at 100 km from Catania, 25 km from Reggio Calabria and 225 km from Palermo airports. Messina is located at 50 km from Taormina, important Town on the Est coast of Sicily, famous for its Historical Heritage and location of the international annual Film Festival.

Messina can be easily reached by train or by bus from Catania, Palermo and Reggio Calabria.

Details about transportation and accommodation will be provided on the Meeting web site. Several parallel events in conjunction with the Meeting will give the participants the opportunity to get acquainted with the scientific and historical heritage of Sicily.

**Travel information and hotel reservation:** Special reservations can be made for the participants in selected hotels in Messina within about 500 meters from the Meeting venue. Shuttle transportation will be provided to all participants on behalf of the organizers to Reggio Calabria, where special sessions and cultural excursions will take place. **c) Abstract format:** Abstracts must provide 1) Title of the contribution, 2) Name(s) of the contributor(s), 3) a brief Summary with essential bibliography of the proposed contribution (MAX. 2000 characters, including bibliography and spaces).

The abstract should be produced as a digital file Word 97-2003 (**\*.doc file**), named after the surname(s) of the contributor(s).
